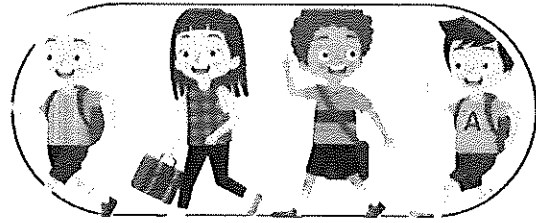


KINDERGARTEN READY

LANGUAGE AND COMMUNICATION

- ☐ Recognize and name letters of the alphabet
- ☐ Recognize and name basic colors and shapes
- ☐ Understand and follow simple directions
- ☐ Engage in basic conversation

FINE MOTOR SKILL

- ☐ Hold a pencil or crayon with a proper grip
- ☐ Cut with scissors along a straight line
- ☐ String beads or manipulate small objects
- ☐ Stack blocks or build simple structures

GROSS MOTOR SKILLS

- ☐ Run, jump, and hop with coordination
- ☐ Balance on one foot for a short period
- ☐ Catch and throw a ball with some accuracy
- ☐ Climb stairs independently

INDEPENDENCE AND SELF-HELP

- ☐ Dress and undress independently
- ☐ Use the restroom and wash hands
- ☐ Pack and unpack a backpack
- ☐ Open lunch containers and food wrappers

SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL SKILLS

- ☐ Share toys and take turns with others
- ☐ Follow basic classroom rules and routines
- ☐ Manage emotions and express feelings verbally
- ☐ Work collaboratively in a group

COGNITIVE SKILLS

- ☐ Identify and count numbers 1-10 or higher
- ☐ Sort objects by color, shape, or size
- ☐ Solve simple puzzles or matching games
- ☐ Follow basic sequencing or patterns
- ☐ Demonstrate an interest in books and storytelling
