These were developed to decrease the gap in high-quality education, as the academic expectations of school districts across America differ. When school districts around the nation adopt the same or "common" rigorous standards, students have better opportunities for high-quality education, regardless of where they live. With Common Core Standards, all students, regardless of their learning level, are equipped with the skills they need to thrive not just in their communities but in an increasingly global economy and society.

The Arizona College and Career Ready Standards are learning goals that apply specifically to K-12 Arizona students. Arizona's educational standards are implemented for all academic areas—English, math, the arts, technology, science, social studies,

In the areas also covered by Common Core Standards—English and math—the expectations reflect the more recently implemented Common Core guidelines.
